# Sure-White<sup>®</sup> EPDM Fully Adhered Roofing Systems

## Installation

Carlisle's Sure-White Fully Adhered Roofing Systems utilize 60- or 90-mil non-reinforced membranes that meet CRRC, LEED<sup>®</sup> and Title 24 guidelines designed to reduce air conditioning costs.

Insulation is either mechanically fastened to the roof deck every 2 square feet or adhered with Flexible FAST Adhesive. Membrane is adhered to the insulation with Carlisle-approved bonding adhesive. Adjoining sheets of Sure-White EPDM are spliced together a minimum of 3" using Carlisle's SecurTAPE<sup>™</sup> or Factory-Applied Tape seam technology.

The above information represents a typical Carlisle Fully Adhered Roofing System. Refer to Carlisle's published specifications and details for more complete information.

#### Membrane and System Strengths

- » Carlisle manufactures all major components of the roof system
- » Dimensionally stable in both hot and cold climates
- » Factory-Applied Tape seam technology and Pressure-Sensitive Flashing accessories enhance workmanship quality
- » Meets Cool Roof Rating Council guidelines for reflectivity, designed to reduce air conditioning costs primarily in warmer southern climates

Caution: A heating penalty may be associated with white roofs in central and northern climates and may be more prone to condensation accumulation.

- » 60-mil and 90-mil membranes available for up to 25 and 30 year warranties
- » 60-mil available in 10', 16 ½', and 20' widths, which reduces the total number of seams required and improves productivity. 90-mil available in 10' width
- » Carlisle's Fully Adhered Roof System offers design flexibility, addresses unconventional building configurations and conforms to steeply sloped roof designs
- » Carlisle's CAV-GRIP<sup>®</sup> III and Low-VOC Bonding Adhesive have a significant cold weather flash off time advantage
- » SAT<sup>™</sup> (Self-Adhering Technology) and FleeceBACK<sup>®</sup> options available

### **System Codes**

- » UL Class A and B ratings are available over most deck types.
- » FM uplift ratings of up to 1-120 are available.

#### **Quality Assurance**

Carlisle Authorized Applicators have been trained to install Fully Adhered Roofing Systems.

#### Inspection

Upon installation completion, and prior to the issuance of a membrane system warrranty, an inspection will be conducted by a Carlisle Field Service Representative.

#### Warranty

Consult your Authorized Applicator or Carlisle Manufacturer's Representative/Distributor for associated warranty charges.

This system properly installed and inspected on a commercial project may receive:

- » A 10-, 15-, 20-, 25- or 30-year (90-mil required) Golden Seal<sup>™</sup> Total System Warranty when all materials used for the roofing installation are manufactured or marketed by Carlisle.
- » A 1" hail warranty is available with 60-mil EPDM and a 2" hail warranty is available with 90-mil EPDM.
- » A maximum peak gust wind speed coverage of 55mph is standard. Additional coverage up to 120 mph is available.
