RE: PIMA QualityMark Certification –Q2 2024 Selection Period (as reported on Jan. 2nd)

The QualityMark Program is a voluntary program for manufacturers of polyisocyanurate roof insulation (ASTM C1289, Type II, Class I, Grade 2) in Canada and the United States. The program enables participants to obtain third-party certification of long-term thermal resistance (LTTR) values for insulation products independently selected from manufacturing locations. LTTR certification testing is completed every three years at each location.

Additionally, the program provides third-party verification of thermal resistance values (R-values) assessed in accordance with the ASTM C518 standard for full-thickness products independently selected from distribution locations. R-value verification testing is completed on a continuous basis with samples representing each location on a quarterly basis. Both LTTR-value certification and R-value verification are required components of the program for participating manufacturers.

The following Carlisle Construction Materials manufacturing locations conform to the QualityMark program requirements for the selection period referenced above.
