Size and Coverage Rate

- 2 ft² per tile
- 12" wide x 24" long
- 5.48 lbs/ft² fully saturated
- Minimum 95% vegetative coverage

Installation

1. Remove the tiles
2. Place the tiles over a minimum 2.5" of Versico's compacted and pre-moistened growth media
3. Place additional tiles with edges butted together to within ¼"
4. Once installation is complete, or at the end of the installation day, water the Roof Garden assembly to the point of runoff/full saturation
