The GreenGrid modules feature a very thin edge that is easily hidden by vegetation while maintaining their modular features that allow for easy installation and removal. GreenGrid G5 modules maintain the functionality of the original GreenGrid modules with improved structural design and stormwater retention.

Stormwater Management

GreenGrid Roof Garden Systems help alleviate stormwater runoff through retention and detention of precipitation. This benefit can cut costs associated with required municipal on-site stormwater retention.

Extends Roof Life

GreenGrid Roof Garden modules can protect the roof membrane from ultraviolet radiation and extreme temperature fluctuations, as well as puncture and other physical damage. Minimization of such exposure can improve the long-term performance of the roofing system.

Added Aesthetic Value

GreenGrid Roof Garden Systems provide urban environments with visually pleasing vistas and rooftop gardens. In urban environments, roof gardens also add value by converting space into areas usable for recreation by building occupants. In such locations, the scarcity of real estate makes the addition of a roof garden for such recreation a competitive alternative.

GENERAL INFORMATION


Carlisle's GreenGrid G5 modules come in 2.75" (6.99 cm), 4" (10.16 cm), 6" (15.24 cm), and 8" (29.32 cm) depths in standard 2' x 2' (61 cm x 61 cm) dimensions. Each module is manufactured using 100% pre-consumer recycled linear low or medium density polyethylene protected by UV stabilizers and is black in color.


2.75" Ultra-Extensive and 4" Extensive Systems

GreenGrid Extensive modules are typically composed of deciduous, semi-evergreen, and evergreen "base" species with "accent" species. The base mix is generally composed of five to eight species of Sedum with one to two accent species. Consult Carlisle for plant recommendations.

6" Semi-Intensive and 8" Intensive Systems

Plant selections may include varieties of ornamental and/ or native groundcovers, grasses, perennials, and in some instances, trees and shrubs. Depending on the plant selection, an irrigation system is generally needed. Since these rooftop gardens are similar to a backyard garden, they will require varying degrees of long-term maintenance and care. Contact Carlisle for vegetation suggestions and assistance.
